Items which will be collected are:

1. Washers
2. Dryers
3. Stoves
4. Water heaters (emptied)
5. Dishwashers
6. Metal-tin, copper, and aluminum
7. Small pieces of lumber
8. Furniture
9. Lawn mowers
10. Refrigerators (emptied and clean)
11. Air conditioners
12. Deep freezers (emptied and clean)
13. Batteries
14. Microwaves
15. Vacuum cleaners
16. Carpet

Items which CANNOT be collected are:

1. TV's
2. Computers and printers
3. Tires
4. Liquids in cans including paint
5. Barrels of ashes, etc.
6. Regular garbage items such as: Garbage, etc.

The Hancock County Highway Department, 101 First Street, Carthage, IL will take paint, TV's, Computers and printers and other electronics. Hours of operation are 8:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. on Friday only. For more information call 217-357-3155. A complete list is available at Warsaw City Hall.

Items will not be picked up at residence homes. The Central Drop off area is the Warsaw Burn Pile/City Storage Shed on Water Street. The handicap and elderly will be given assistance for pick up items. If you need assistance, contact City Hall at 217-256-3214 by Thursday, April 22, 2021.
